- 3. Thinking about the benchmarks The Unstuck Group uses to ensure churches are reaching multiple generations (20% of total attendance is kids; 10% is students), how do our percentages measure up?
- 4. Based on these comparisons, how would we rate (on a green/yellow/red scale) our current strategies to reach young families?
