- 1. AMY: "In a growing church, the church is focused and intentional about creating the next steps for people to engage in their discipleship pathway."
- 2. AMY: "In a maintenance church, things like internal preferences, comfort and tradition often drive decision-making, even if those decisions aren't effective."
- 3. AMY: "Being on the senior leadership team is about being fully aligned with the church's mission, being a strategic, big-picture thinker and then bringing energy, not just tasks, to the table."
- 4. AMY: "This process of moving from maintenance to strategic growth will create tension—that's normal and necessary."
- 5. AMY: "Let your leaders carry some of the responsibility on how it's gonna get done; you're giving ownership if you've got trusted leadership around you, not just a to-do list."
